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ELEVATOR PITCH

If elevator pitch is a new phrase for you: imagine you step into an elevator with someone and they ask you a question. You only have the length of the elevator ride to speak your answer, because then they will exit the elevator and walk away forever. You want your answer to be short, sweet, and to the point, so that your elevator companion doesn't walk away with more questions than answers. Typical "pitches" that you want to be prepared for are answers to questions like: "Tell us about yourself?", "What's your platform/charity about?", "Why do you want the title of QUEEN OF THE CHESAPEAKE?", "Why should we pick you over the other contestants?", etc. Your pitch should be roughly 30 secs.

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SCORING BREAKDOWN & CRITERIA

Interview Process:

ACHIEVEMENTS – 20%

The Contestant's achievements will count for 20% of her final score. Her achievement score will be based on the information she provides in the achievement section of her Queen of the Chesapeake Pageant Application. Achievements can include any extracurricular activities, leadership experience, academic honors, and awards received. Categories include school honors, sports activities, school organizations, and community activities.

INTERVIEW – 25%

The interviews will count for 25% of your overall score. Interview questions will be pulled from your Elevator Pitch and the information that the Contestant supplies in the Achievement section of their Pageant Application. Contestants are expected to wear business attire to the interview, along with their sash and crown.

Pageant:

ESSAY - 20%

The Contestant's essay will count for 20% of her final score. Her essay should be 200-225 words on the specific topic which is included in her application. It should be submitted with her completed pageant application. Content will be the primary scoring criteria for this category. Following guidelines and using proper grammar will be considered as well in this category.

OPENINGS - 15%

The Contestant's total number of yacht club openings that she has attended this season will be prorated for 15% of her final score. Her attendance at openings reflects her participation and commitment to the yacht club community. She will announce this number during her introduction on Pageant Day. The judges will calculate her openings score using the following scale: One point per opening with the maximum amount of points available being 15.

POISE/PRESENTATION – 20%

The Contestant's poise/presentation will count for 20% of her final score. The Contestant's poise/presentation score will be based on the judges 'overall impression while she is escorted, seated on stage, and speaking publicly during the Pageant. They will be looking for her ability to speak effectively and intelligently during her introduction, speech, and while answering questions. Her score will also be influenced by her ability to command both the judges 'and the audience's attention by her poise and confidence.

If you need to put your essay on a separate sheet of paper, please do so, but include the essay topic and your name of the top of the sheet.

Violations of the Code of Conduct should be reported first to to a a responsible adult for assistance based on their club's established protocols. This can include a parent or other chaperone, a member of their princess committee, or their Commodore. If the Violation is of illegal activity, notify a Queen of the Chesapeake Committee member immediately. The offending Princess's Commodore will be informed of violations by the QOTC Committee. Misconduct will be evaluated by the Committee and may result in dismissal from the Queen of the Chesapeake Program. As a result, the offending Princess will be unable to participate in the Queen of the Chesapeake activities, nor compete in the Pageant.

All decisions of the Queen of the Chesapeake Committee are final.
